- 586 **Q:** This is the oil used in the sacrament of Holy Orders.

- 675 **Q:** She was married to the first Catholic king of France, named Clovis.
A: Who is St. Clotilde?
-
- 676 **Q:** A Society which today helps the poor is named after this saint who spent his life helping the poor.

- 677 **Q:** This Hungarian saint was loved by the poor. One day according to tradition, while taking food to the poor, she was stopped and flowers fell out of her cloak.
