FRONT DOOR USE

SCHOOLYARD SUPERVISION

TLA provides school yard supervision from 8:30-8:45 AM, and from 3:00-3:15 PM. Parents who wish to supervise their own children in the school yard before or after those times are welcome to do so, but elementary aged students must not be left in the schoolgrounds unsupervised. TLA offers after school care for those unable to collect their students by 3:15.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE AVAILABLE AT TLA

After school care is now available at TLA on schooldays until 5:30 PM, for students aged 5 - 12, provided by Gamesters FUNdamentals, Inc. SCHOOL UNIFORM NOTICE
